

„Pass Egal Wahl“ – Vote now!

DEM21 – an Upper Austrian initiative that works to sensitize about the exclusion of different people from the right to vote – has started its activities under the feature „**Pass Egal Wahl**“. This term stands for the possibility to vote regardless of your nationality or passport and should raise the awareness of the exclusion of a **considerable part of the population in Upper Austria** from the elections on September 26th 2021.

The Upper Austrian "Pass Egal Wahl" takes place **from August 23rd to September 17th**. Regardless of the passport, everyone who lives in Upper Austria and is over 16 years, can vote! The same parties, which are running for the Upper Austrian state elections, are on the "Pass Egal" ballot.

The "Pass Egal Wahl" postal vote works like this:

1. Get a small envelope (format C6, 114 mm x 162 mm) and a large envelope (format C5, 162 mm x 229 mm).
2. Download the voting and identification slip [HERE](#). Print it out and cut them into two pieces.
3. First fill out the voting slip and put it in the small envelope. Seal the small envelope.
4. Put the sealed envelope in the large envelope.
5. Then fill out the identification slip and put it in the large envelope.
6. Seal the large envelope and write the code word: "Pass Egal Wahl" on it.
